



## Standing Rock Sioux Tribe COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Program Community Schedule

The Standing Rock Sioux Tribe believes in the effectiveness and benefit of vaccinating against the COVID-19 virus and is encouraging all community members of the Standing Rock Indian Reservation to obtain a vaccine. The Tribal Council developed the COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Program to respond directly to COVID-19 public health emergency by providing an incentive to increase the number of tribal enrolled members who choose to get vaccinated and/or motivate enrolled tribal members to receive the Vaccine sooner than they otherwise would have, or to incentivize members to get the COVID-19 booster in accordance with CDC and FDA guidelines.

We have provided a community schedule for all vaccinated tribal enrolled members to submit their applications for the SRST Vaccine Incentive Program. You must have both of your shots of Moderna or Pfizer, or one shot of Johnson & Johnson.

- Signed application with tribal enrollment number
- Signed acknowledgement form
- **Original** COVID-19 Vaccination Record or an immunization record.
